On the First Sunday of Advent the Bishops of England and Wales changed our lectionary. Although the readings, at Mass, remain the same the translation of the words are different using the English Standard Version of the Bible. The changes are intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, the latest scholarship and where appropriate be more inclusive. Saint Jerome said, 'Ignorance of the scriptures is ignorance of Christ.' The Second Vatican Council made it clear that, 'Christ is as present in the scriptures as he is in the sacraments.' Whilst Our Lord declared, 'Heaven and Earth will pass away but my words will never pass away.' I wonder what God might be saying to us through His word on this Second Sunday of Advent. 
